Minute Summary for 20 April 2023

- 1) Grounds: 30' of tent space will be added to the Beer Garden area to showcase the raffle items where there is more foot traffic. Everest Tents will provide tables, chairs, tents, and Space Walk of Wausau will provide the inflatables. **Volunteers are needed**: 15 people for Setup on Saturday, June 10 from 9:00 – 11:00 and 15 people for Takedown on Sunday, June 11 from 4:00 – 6:00 p.m. To volunteer contact the Parish Offices at 715.359.5206
- 2) Food: Food trucks currently confirmed are DC Everest Optimists (hamburgers, brats, cheese curds), Geno's Bake Shoppe (cream puff, donut holes, elephant ears), and Chang Best Eggrolls (Hmong egg rolls, fried rice, crab Rangoon). Soda and water will be sold by the Boy Scouts.
- 3) Cash Raffle: Drawing for the raffle will at 3:30 p.m. Raffle tickets are ready for the parishioners and over half the envelopes have been picked up! John Klosinski has built a new raffle ticket drum.
- 4) Large Item Raffle: a) Tickets for a separate raffle for a rifle are set at 1 ticket/\$10 or 3 tickets/\$20. b) Other Large item raffle tickets \$5 each: 1) Family tent; 2) garden gnome set, 3) a trailer load of cut firewood, 3) Wisconsin Wine basket including electric wine bottle opener. 4) Two additional items were suggested **if funding is received**, a firepit table and a collapsible wagon with family fun items. Free will offerings will be accepted for the cards. **Gift cards are needed for prizes**. b), c) Cake Walk with Girl Scout volunteers (**more volunteers needed**), Cake donations **will be received** Saturday, from 9:00 – noon, d) Petting Zoo: Kraft's Kuddly Kritters from 1:00 -3:00 p.m. e) Kids Games: 1) NCES St Mark Home and School will organize the games (**teen volunteers are needed**), 2) Catholic Financial Life will also provide games. **Prizes are needed for the games**. 3) Ace Hardware Kids Club Crafts will be provided and staffed by Ace Hardware.
