Greetings to you! The parish leadership team is inviting St. Mark adult parishioners, registered and non-registered, to complete a short Parish Life Survey. Your feedback on the survey will help evaluate St. Mark’s effectiveness in meeting the pastoral needs of its parishioners, and offer guidance in setting goals and priorities going forward. Survey copies are available in the church entrances and parish office. Completed surveys can be placed in the designated boxes at the church entrances or in the parish office by April 21, 2024. We have all benefitted from the wise planning and stewardship of our parishioners who came before us. It’s now our time to plan for the future generations of our parish. We can’t do it well without hearing from you, and your opinion matters!
